In January 2007, Skytanking signed a 30-year concession with Stuttgart International Airport Limited to build, own and operate the open-access jet-fuel storage system for the new airport.

- 3 x 1,500 m³ Jet A-1 tanks
- Into-plane company offices and vehicle maintenance facility
- Aviation gasoline (Avgas) storage tank and dispensing equipment
- Diesel service station for airport vehicles
- Total investment €9 million
