The fuel facility

The fuel facility comprises:

- 3 x 1,500 m³ Jet A -1 tanks
- Into-plane company offices and vehicle maintenance facility
- Aviation gasoline (Avgas) storage tank and dispensing equipment
- Diesel service station for airport vehicles
- Total Investment € 9 million
